The hospital has an accredited level 3 trauma unit and a robust Intensive Care Unit. The Northern Simulation Centre offers opportunities for simulation-based learning and teaching.

The Department provides anesthetic services for a wide range of surgical specialties including General Surgery, Urology, Orthopedics, Plastics, ENT, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Ophthalmology, and Vascular Surgery. On-call commitment is approximately 1 in 8. The department works under an Alternative Payment arrangement, with an estimated base remuneration of approximately \$500,000 for a full-time position (1.0 FTE = 1997 hours per annum).
