

CAS Divisional Representative Nomination Ontario – Dr Vatsal Trivedi



Dr. Vatsal Trivedi is a Cardiac Anesthesiologist and Critical Care Physician at Trillium Health Partners in Mississauga. He has completed his medical training at McMaster University, following by residency training in Anesthesiology among the inaugural CBME cohort at the University of Ottawa. Thereafter, he completed a second Royal College residency in Adult Critical Care Medicine, followed by further fellowship training in Cardiac Anesthesiology and Perioperative Transesophageal Echocardiography.

He is appointed at the rank of Assistant Professor within the Department of Anesthesiology and Pain Medicine at the University of Toronto. He is currently the Director of Education in the Trillium Health Partners Cardiac Surgical ICU, and is also

appointed as an Investigator at the associated Institute for Better Health.

His clinical interests include the care of critically ill patients, perioperative transesophageal echocardiography, as well as mechanical cardiorespiratory support, and minimally invasive cardiac surgery.

His academic interests include leadership in residency and fellowship education. He was recently awarded a Clinical Teacher of the Year award from the Division of Critical Care Medicine at the University of Toronto. He leads numerous quality improvement initiatives within the cardiac surgical ICU at Trillium Health, including their Enhanced Recovery after Cardiac Surgery (ERACS) program, and mentors medical students in their QI projects within the Mississauga Academy of Medicine in the University of Toronto School of Medicine.

He currently serves as the Vice Chair of the Ontario Anesthesiology section of the OMA. Finally he is also among the incoming class of Executive MBA candidates at the Rotman School of Management at the University of Toronto.
