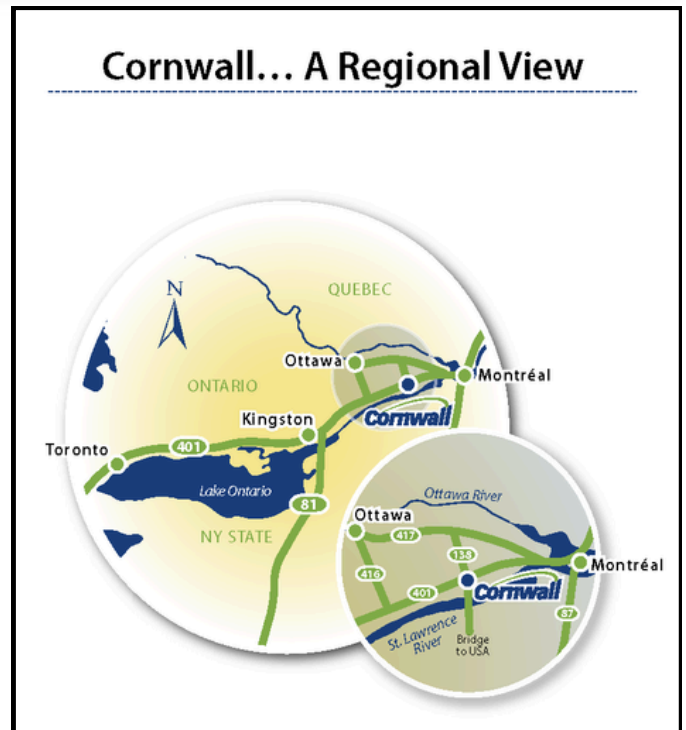

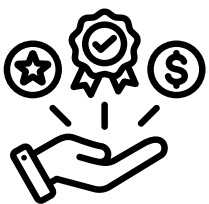
Why Choose Cornwall?
