Build a focused outpatient practice in headache and pain medicine without hospital call or perioperative duties. The Headache, Migraine & Concussion Centre (HMCC) is seeking an anesthesiologist with chronic pain, interventional pain, or headache-management experience to join our established clinic in Ajax, Ontario.

Important: This is not a traditional anesthesia position. The role does not involve general anesthesia, sedation, airway management, operating-room coverage, hospital call, or inpatient care.

The opportunity

This is a fee-for-service associate position with a flexible schedule. The successful physician may begin with one or two clinic days per month and grow to one or two days per week, depending on availability and mutual fit. An earlier start is welcomed, but timing can accommodate licensing, credentialing, and existing commitments.

Clinical scope

The physician will assess and manage adult patients with chronic migraine, headache disorders, concussion-related headache, and selected chronic pain conditions. Clinical activities may include:

- Outpatient consultations, follow-up care, and evidence-informed medication management
- Greater occipital nerve blocks
- Supraorbital, auriculotemporal, and zygomaticotemporal nerve blocks
- Trigger-point injections
- OnabotulinumtoxinA injections for chronic migraine

Why HMCC

- Established community referral network and a significant patient waitlist
- Dedicated administrative and clinical support, rooms, equipment, supplies, scheduling, and billing infrastructure
- No requirement to build a practice from the ground up
- Weekday daytime practice with no evening, weekend, on-call, or hospital coverage requirements
- Collaborative, patient-centred environment focused on non-narcotic headache and pain care

Qualifications and practice eligibility

- Anesthesiologist with relevant experience or training in chronic pain, interventional pain, or headache medicine
- Current CPSO registration for independent practice, or a clear and realistic pathway to Ontario licensure
- Training, competence, and CPSO-recognized scope appropriate to all consultations and procedures performed
- Good standing with the CPSO and appropriate professional liability protection
- Commitment to compassionate, collaborative, and evidence-informed patient care

Hospital privileges are not required for this position. HMCC is a CPSO Out-of-Hospital Premises Level 1 facility and cannot provide hospital-based training for a physician who requires training or formal approval to expand their scope of practice. Eligibility will be reviewed before onboarding.

Compensation

Competitive fee-for-service compensation based on collected billings. HMCC provides clinic space, staffing, equipment, supplies, scheduling, billing, and administrative support. Terms will reflect experience, practice readiness, and anticipated clinical commitment.
