

PRACTICE OPPORTUNITY: Anesthesiologist

The Department of Anesthesia at Grand River and St. Mary's General Hospital are recruiting Anesthesiologists for locum and full time positions in the Kitchener – Waterloo area.

Kitchener- Waterloo is one of Canada's fastest growing communities. With almost 1 in 4 residents born outside Canada, Waterloo Region is a culturally diverse area to reside. KW generates the 2nd highest number of startups in North America creating a very strong high tech sector. Waterloo Region is home to two high calibre universities (University of Waterloo and Wilfrid Laurier), and also Canada's largest trade school, Conestoga College.

Grand River Hospital and St. Mary's General Hospital are two separately governed hospitals that function as an integrated system with well-defined and complementary clinical programs to serve both the local community and the region. Each hospital has an acute care ER with patient volumes reaching approximately 55,000 visits/annum. St. Mary's General Hospital is a Regional Cardiac Care Centre and a Centre of Excellence for Respiratory and Thoracic Care. Grand River Hospital hosts several regional programs including the Grand River Regional Cancer Centre, Hepatobiliary Surgical Program, and stroke, renal and mental health programmes.

Anesthesia Associates provides services to a busy obstetrical unit, acute pain service, and surgical programs in orthopedic, spine, cardiac, thoracic, ENT, urology, gynecology, plastic, maxillofacial, general, ophthalmology and emergency surgery. The scope of practice provides both adult and some pediatric anesthesiology. We have also added a dedicated regional block room and electrophysiology lab in 2020. A specific subgroup of anesthesiologists within Anesthesia Associates provides services for our cardiac program. Our surgeons perform approximately 10,000 procedures each year.

Anesthesiologists have the opportunity to teach medical students and residents through our affiliation with McMaster University Michael G. Degroote School of Medicine and there are opportunities for an academic appointment.

Candidates must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and hold FRCPC certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Anesthesiology.

Payment is fee for service.
