The Women's and Obstetric Anesthesia department consists of a team of 10 Obstetric Fellowship-trained anesthesiologists (plus five anesthesia assistants, one anesthesia technician and two research staff) who provide a full range of labour analgesia and obstetric anesthesia services with 5,000 deliveries each year. In addition, the team serves gynecology and breast health anesthetic needs (2000 surgeries annually).

We are also affiliated with **Nova Scotia Health Authority's Central Zone** and the **QEII Health Science Centre**, Atlantic Canada's largest tertiary/quaternary care facility with 70,000 procedures completed annually. At the QEII, anesthesiologists deliver the full spectrum of general and specialty anesthesia services, perioperative and critical care medicine, and acute and chronic pain management.

Qualifications

Requirements include eligibility for Nova Scotia medical licensure and Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification (or equivalent) in anesthesia, subspecialty training in women's and obstetrics anesthesia, research training (CIP, MSc, PhD) and a track record in scholarly research.
