

## ANAESTHESIA ASSISTANT

Working with the Saskatchewan Health Authority as an Anaesthesia Assistant, you will work in acute care facilities to provide clinical assistance to anaesthetists.

You will participate in the care of the surgical patient through medical directives under the supervision of the Anaesthesiologist as well as calibrating, troubleshooting and performing repairs on anaesthetic equipment to ensure optimum care for patients!

## **Qualifications:**

- Anaesthesia diploma (DA)
- Current registration or eligibility for registration in the province of Saskatchewan as a Respiratory Therapist or Registered Nurse with critical care experience (preferred)

## **Licenses:**

- Advanced Cardiac Life Support Certificate (ACLS)
- Pediatric Advanced Life Support Certificate (PALS)
- Maintains current certifications for endotracheal intubation, peripheral venous cannulation, blood salvaging, arterial cannulation, drug preparation and administration
